# **Summer Courses 2025**

### General information

- **COURSE DATES**: All summer courses are taught in person and **begin on June 3**. Courses take place every weekday except June 24 and July 1. The final exam date is included in the dates listed.
- MAXIMUM COURSES: You may take a maximum of two summer courses.
- **UNPAID TUITION**: You may not register if you have an outstanding tuition balance.
- **COURSES AT ANOTHER COLLEGE**: You may be given authorization to register for a course at another college **only if**Marianopolis does not offer a course that you need this summer to graduate or in order to proceed with your courses in the fall. Please MIO an Academic Advisor if you are in this situation.
- COURSE CANCELLATIONS: Courses are subject to change or cancellation without prior notice.

## Registration for Marianopolis students

#### If you are graduating this summer:

- Registration: April 23 and 24, 10:00 14:00, room A-269
- Payment deadline: April 30; through online banking

If you are returning in the fall and you are behind by one or more courses in your progression (e.g. due to failure, dropped courses, incompletes, reduced course load):

- Registration: April 28 and 29, 10:00 14:00, room A-269
- Payment deadline: May 6; through online banking

#### If you fail a course in the Winter 2025 semester:

- When you receive your final grade, you may register with an Academic Advisor during regular drop-in hours. The <u>last day</u> to register is June 2, 14:00, in room A-269.
- Payment deadline: Payment must be made the day you register, through online banking

If you are not behind by any courses but you want to get ahead in your progression, registration is permitted where space allows:

- Registration: June 2, 16:00 17:00, room A-269
- Payment deadline: Payment must be made the day you register, through online banking

# Registration for students from other colleges

#### If you are graduating this summer:

- An Academic Advisor at your college must send a commandite form by May 23, 4pm.
- You will receive an <u>email on June 2 by 4:00</u> to inform you whether you have been registered in the course. The <u>payment</u> <u>deadline</u> is June 3, through online banking.
